New LED lighting will improve energy efficiency still further. RECYCLING AND RE-USING

Paperless planning is easier as well as friendlier, with all pre-registration information at the touch of a button. And because everything is automatically recycled at the end of the day, there's no need for 'recycling stations' in our meeting rooms. Most items are always re-usable rather than disposable, such as china and glassware, linen napkins, ceramic creamers and sugar dispensers. 100% of our non-food waste is either re-cycled or used to generate electricity.

THOUGHT FOR FOOD

Most of our ingredients are locally sourced, always in season and always from ethical suppliers we know and trust. With your wellbeing in mind, they're also healthy and nutritionally balanced. Our chefs are happy to design menus exclusively for you, so you'll always know the provenance of your food, and new menus will even include carbohydrate and calorie counts. Our water is also purified and bottled in-house, avoiding transportation.
